#### **General description** 1.

The 74HC164-Q100; 74HCT164-Q100 is an 8-bit serial-in/parallel-out shift register. The device features two serial data inputs (DSA and DSB), eight parallel data outputs (Q0 to Q7). Data is entered serially through DSA or DSB and either input can be used as an active HIGH enable for data entry through the other input. Data is shifted on the LOW-to-HIGH transitions of the clock (CP) input. A LOW on the master reset input (MR) clears the register and forces all outputs LOW, independently of other inputs. Inputs include clamp diodes that enable the use of current limiting resistors to interface inputs to voltages in excess of V<sub>CC</sub>.

This product has been qualified to the Automotive Electronics Council (AEC) standard Q100 (Grade 1) and is suitable for use in automotive applications.





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




Fig 8. Waveforms showing the master reset (MR) pulse width, the master reset to output (Qn) propagation delays and the master reset to clock (CP) removal time

Fig 10. Test circuit for measuring switching times








Fig 13. Package outline SOT762-1 (DHVQFN14)
