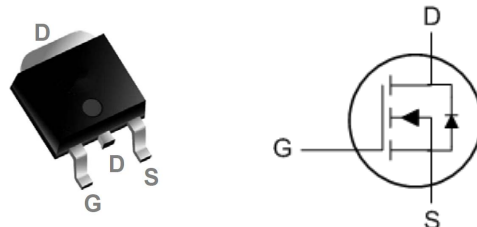

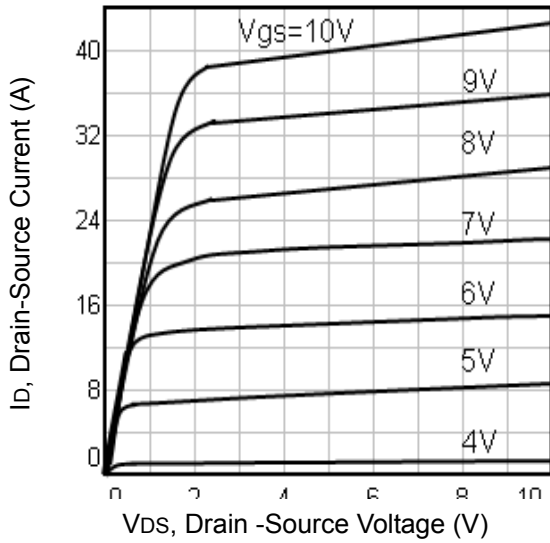


Fig1. Typical Output Characteristics

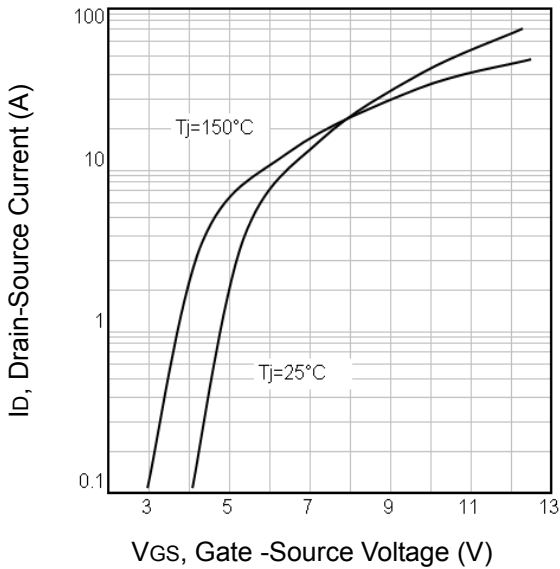
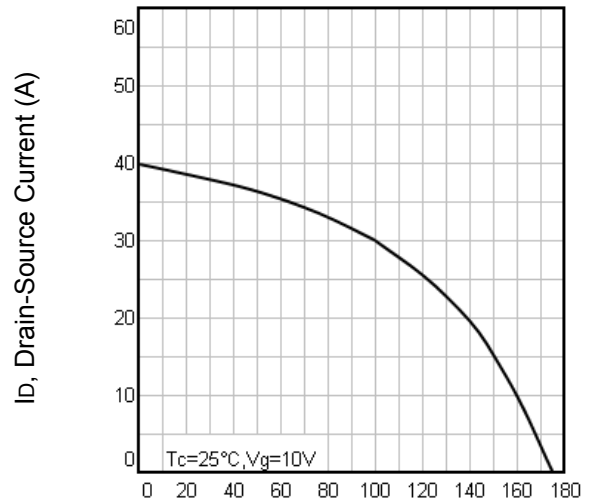


Fig3. Typical Transfer Characteristics

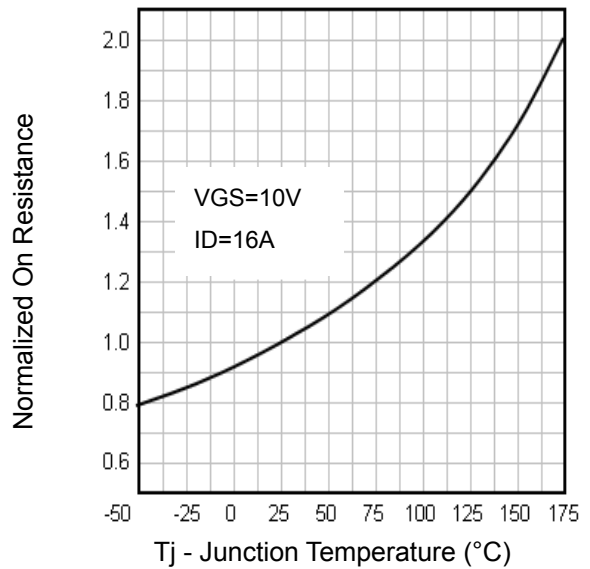


Fig4. Normalized On-Resistance Vs. Temperature

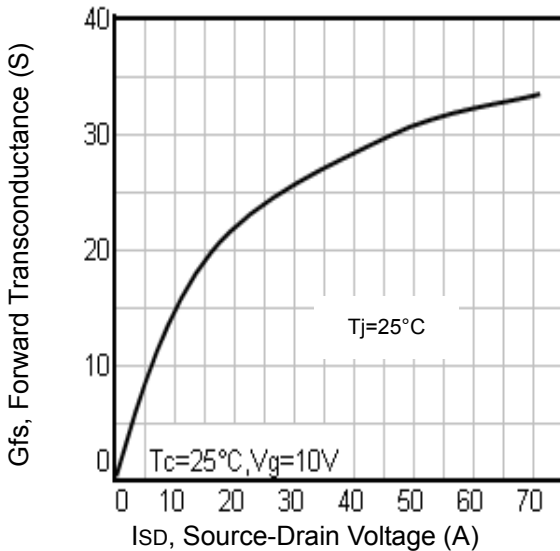


Fig5. Typical Forward Transconductance Vs. Drain Current

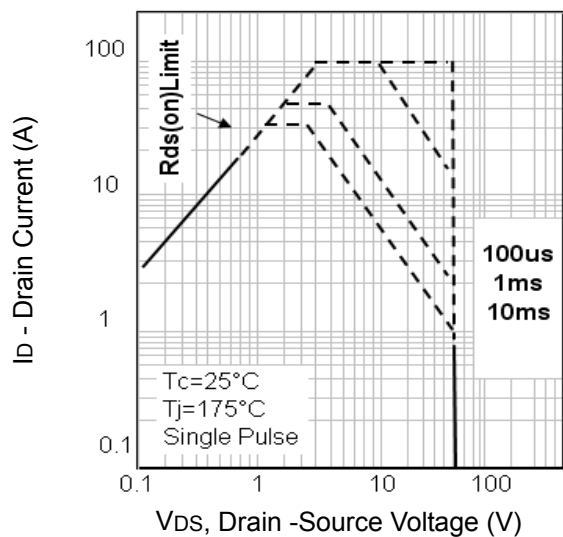


Fig6. Maximum Safe Operating Area

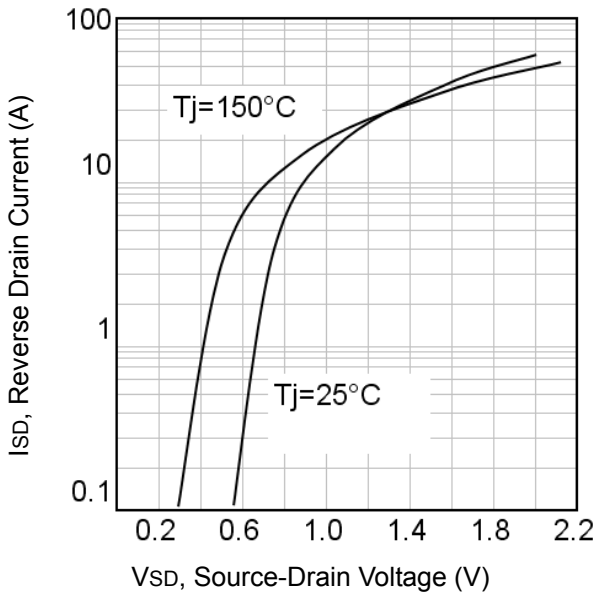


Fig7. Typical Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage

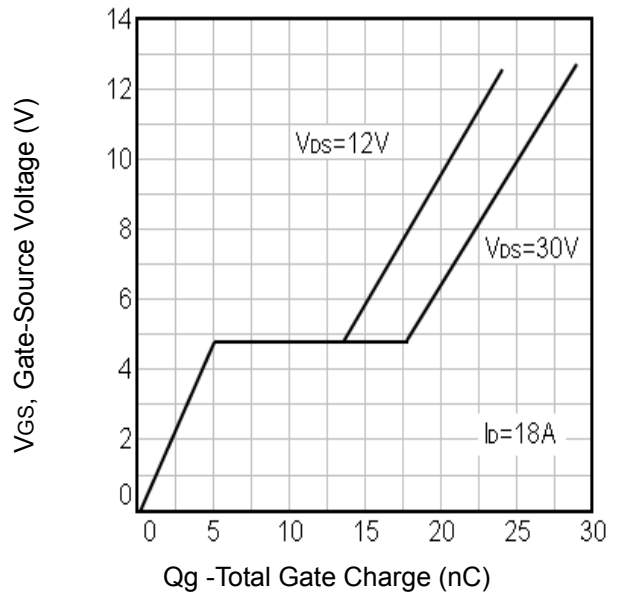


Fig8. Typical Gate Charge Vs. Gate-Source Voltage

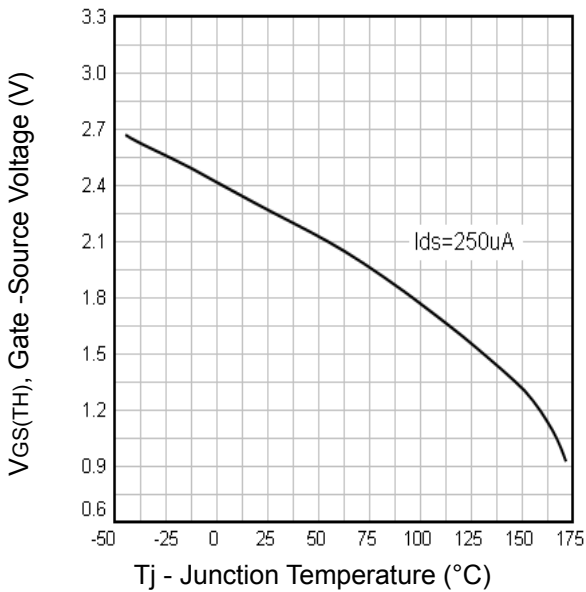


Fig9. Threshold Voltage Vs. Temperature

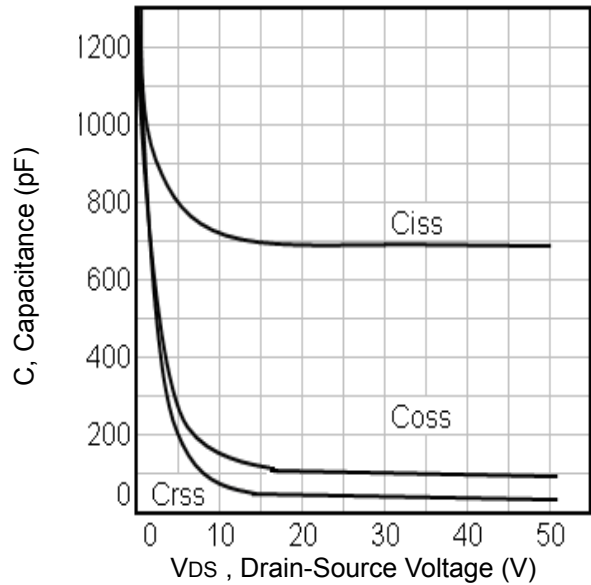


Fig10. Typical Capacitance Vs. Drain-Source Voltage

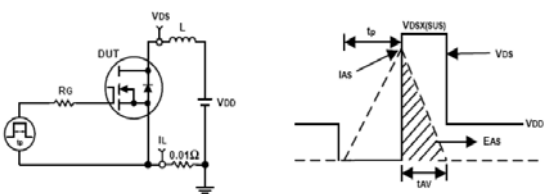


Fig11. Unclamped Inductive Test Circuit and waveforms

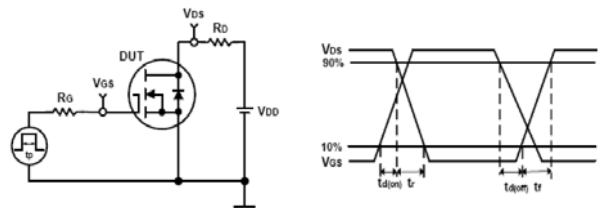


Fig12. Switching Time Test Circuit and waveforms



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
