


Fig.1 Typical Output Characteristics




Fig.3 Forward Characteristics Of Reverse




Fig.5 Normalized V_{GS(th)} vs. T_J




Fig.2 On-Resistance vs. Gate-Source




Fig.4 Gate-Charge Characteristics





Fig.6 Normalized R_{DSON} vs. T_J








Fig.7 Capacitance

Fig.8 Safe Operating Area




Fig.9 Normalized Maximum Transient Thermal Impedance




Fig.10 Switching Time Waveform




Fig.11 Gate Charge Waveform



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
