




Fig.1 Typical Output Characteristics




Fig.3 Forward Characteristics of Reverse




Fig.5 Normalized V_{GS(th)} v.s T_J




Fig.2 On-Resistance v.s Gate-Source




Fig.4 Gate-Charge Characteristics





Fig.6 Normalized R_{DSON} v.s T_J








Fig.7 Capacitance

Fig.8 Safe Operating Area






Fig.9 Normalized Maximum Transient Thermal Impedance








Fig.11 Unclamped Inductive Switching Waveform



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
