

Fig.1 Forward Current Derating Curve




Fig.3 Typical Instantaneous Forward Characteristics





Fig.5 Typical Junction Capacitance

Fig.2 Maximum Non-Repetitive Peak




Fig.4 Typical Reverse Characteristics
