





**Figure 2 Transfer Characteristics** 




Figure 4 Body diode Characteristics




Figure 5 Rdson- Tj Relation




Figure 7 Capacitance vs Vds

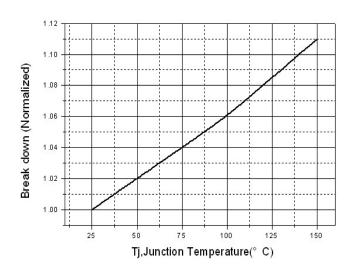


Figure 6 BVDSS vs Junction Temperature






Figure 8 VGS vs QG Characteristics




