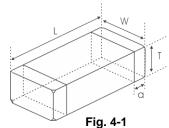

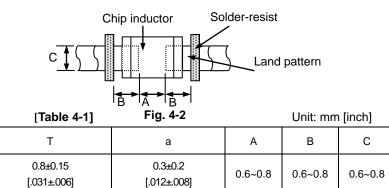

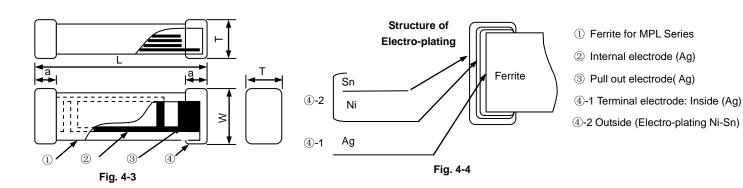

#### 5. Test and Measurement Procedures

#### 5.1 Test Conditions

Unless otherwise specified, the standard atmospheric conditions for measurement/test as:

- a. Ambient Temperature: 20±15°C
- b. Relative Humidity: 65±20%
- c. Air Pressure: 86 kPa to 106 kPa

If any doubt on the results, measurements/tests should be made within the following limits:

- a. Ambient Temperature: 20±2°C
- b. Relative Humidity: 65±5%
- c. Air Pressure: 86kPa to 106 kPa

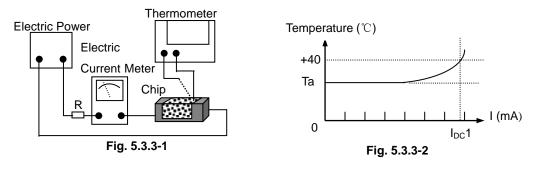

- 5.3.1 DC Resistance (DCR)
  - a. Refer to Item 3.
  - b. Test equipment (Analyzer): High Accuracy Milliohmmeter-HP4338B or equivalent.

#### 5.3.2 Inductance (L)

- a. Refer to Item 3.
- b. Test equipment: High Accuracy RF Impedance /Material Analyzer-HP4291B+HP16192A or equivalent.
- c. Test signal: -20dBm or 50mV.
- d. Test frequency refers to Item 3.
- 5.3.3 Temperature Rise Current (I\_DC1)
  - a. Refer to Item 3.
  - b. Test equipment (see Fig. 5.3.3-1): Electric Power, Electric current meter, Thermometer.
  - c. Measurement method (see Fig. 5.3.3-1):
    - 1. Set test current to be 0 mA.
    - 2. Measure initial temperature of chip surface.
    - 3. Gradually increase voltage and measure chip temperature for corresponding current.

4. Definition of Temperature Rise Current (I<sub>DC</sub>1) : I<sub>DC</sub>1 is direct electric current as chip surface temperature rose just 40°C against chip initial surface temperature (Ta) (see **Fig. 5.3.3-2**)



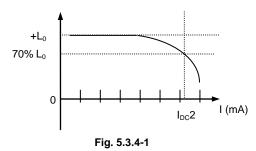
5.3.4 Saturation Current (I<sub>DC</sub>2)

- a. Refer to Item 3.
- b. Test equipment: HP6632B system DC power supply, HP4291B+HP16192A+HP16200A or equivalent.
- c. Measurement method:
  - Measurement conditions of initial inductance L: Measuring Frequency: 1MHz. Test Current: 1mA.
  - 2. Raising the voltage of the DC power supply, measure the inductance at the various current.

The rated current is the value of DC current at which the inductance will be 30% down compared with the initial inductance value.

Note: In the period of raising voltage, voltage cannot be reduced.

3. Definition of Saturation Current ( $I_{DC}2$ ) :  $I_{DC}2$  is the value of DC current as inductance L ( $\mu$ H) decreased just 30% against initial value (see Fig. 5.3.4-1).

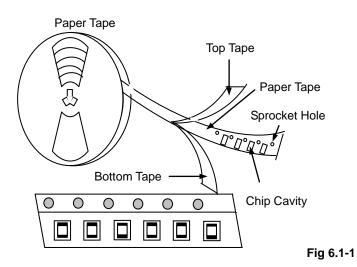

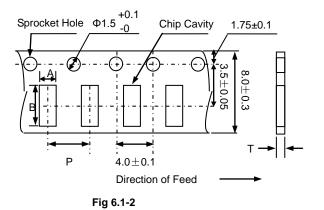

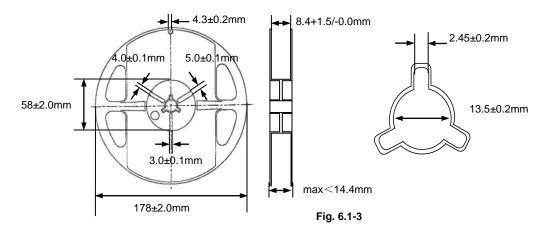


(2) Taping Dimensions (Unit: mm)

#### 6.2 Storage

- a. The solderability of the external electrode may be deteriorated if packages are stored where they are exposed to high humidity. Package must be stored at 40°C or less and 70% RH or less.
- b. The solderability of the external electrode may be deteriorated if packages are stored where they are exposed to dust of harmful gas (e.g. HCl, sulfurous gas of H<sub>2</sub>S).
- c. Packaging material may be deformed if package are stored where they are exposed to heat of direct sunlight.
- d. Solderability specified in **Clause 5.4.6** shall be guaranteed for 12 months from the date of delivery on condition that they are stored at the environment specified in **Clause 3**. For those parts, which passed more than 12 months shall be checked solder-ability before use.

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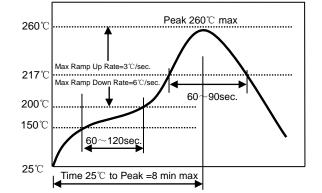

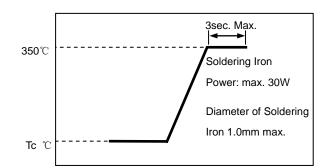
#### 7. Recommended Soldering Technologies

#### 7.1 Reflowing Profile:

- $\triangle$  Preheat condition: 150 ~200°C/60~120sec.
- $\triangle$  Allowed time above 217°C: 60~90sec.
- △ Max temp: 260°C
- $\triangle$  Max time at max temp: 10sec.
- △ Solder paste: Sn/3.0Ag/0.5Cu
- △ Allowed Reflow time: 2x max

[Note: The reflow profile in the above table is only for qualification and is not meant to specify board assembly profiles. Actual board assembly profiles must be based on the customer's specific board design, solder paste and process, and should not exceed the parameters as the Reflow profile shows.]
