


Figure 1. Typical Instantaneous Forward Characteristics

Figure 2. Typical Reverse Characteristics





Figure 3. Typical Junction Capacitance




Figure 7. Typical Transient Thermal Response for NTST40100CT and NTSB40100CT-1G




Figure 8. Typical Transient Thermal Response for NTSJ40100CTG





Figure 9. Typical Transient Thermal Response for NTSB40100CTG


